THE WAY OF CHRIST

Today we have three special celebrations going on. First, it is the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time. Second, it is the Lunar New Year, a major traditional holiday in Korea with a unique inherent custom. We pay ancestral rites remembering our ancestors, perform se-bae which pays tribute to parents, relatives, elders by bowing with exchanging good wishes, and get a cash gift from our elders called se-baedon. After that, we eat tteokguk as a communal meal followed by various folk games such as yutnori, neolttwigi (jump on a seesaw), and kite flying. You will experience a few of these today during and after Mass.

Third, today is 'God's Word Sunday'. Pope Francis declared the Third Sunday of the Ordinary Time as a day dedicated to reflect the word of God (September 30, 2019) by way of our living.

In the Gospel today, Jesus began his public life. He summarizes the theme of his entire public life in one sentence: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

He calls us to "repent" or to reform our lives. His call is demanding: a metanoia, a total change of heart, a complete transformation of one's life, a radical decision for God. It's a challenge for you and me to respond to his call. Such a radical decision means the mystery of Jesus becomes our way of life. Repent means all our deepest questions about human life are answered in the person of Christ.

Then he explains why repent, because "The kingdom of heaven is at hand." The kingdom of God can be expressed as doing the will of God. This will of God is what we pray for at the heart of the Lord's prayer Jesus taught: "Your will be done / on earth as in heaven" (Matthew 6:10). This will of God is the summary of Jesus' own life: He said "Behold I come to do your will, O God" (Hebrews 10:7). For Jesus, this doing the will of God means accepting whatever came to him with submission and love. Jesus is our way, so we too try to accept our human lives in the spirit of Jesus. Following Jesus means accept-

ing the reality of our lives just as it comes to us. God's will is that we accept everything that comes to us naturally as the way of life just as Jesus did.

The late Pope Benedict XVI puts a new light on today's Jesus' essential proclamation:

"The kingdom of heaven is at hand." In his book, Jesus of Nazareth, he explains:

Christ uses these words to refer to himself: He, who is in our midst, is the Kingdom Of God. . . . The new proximity of the kingdom... is to be found in Jesus himself. Through Jesus' presence and action, God is here and now entered into history in a wholly new way. The reason why now is in a unique sense... the time of joy, is that in Jesus it is God who draws near to us.... Christ uses these words to refer to himself. He, who is in our midst, is the "Kingdom of God".... To proclaim this good news, Jesus needs to form his team. So, he called two brothers Simon Peter and Andrew. At once they left their nets and followed

Then, he called two other brothers James and John who were with their father in a boat mending their nets. They immediately left their boat and their father and followed him.

He now calls us today through this liturgy of the word. How would you respond?

In the Gospel, Jesus is portrayed as a captivating, genuine and charismatic person. He does not back away from Galilee where Herod Antipas has imprisoned John. Rather he goes about "all of Galilee" (Matt 4:23; NAB). He does not wait for people to come to him and ask to be his disciple. He assertively chooses them. This directness honors them, and they leave everything behind (family, their possession, job) to follow him. Jesus is a forthright energy, and this energy fascinates them who seek truth. They want to know more about where this man is coming from. They hoped he would bring justice, satisfaction and passion. As Martin Luther asked, "What drives Christ?" Christ is only too willing to tell us, and so we continue to go back to his story to learn from him, to make our own - the Spirit that drives him.

Marsha Linehan is a prominent American psychologist who devoted her whole life for a cause she experienced during her own childhood and adolescence. She was diagnosed with schizophrenia where she was an inpatient, and subjected to all kinds of treatment, but none helped her. When she was 18 years old, she dealt with suicidal behavior. She grew up in a solid Catholic

family as the third child out of six.

She was interested in suicide. So, she decided and made a vow that she was going to spend her life going into hell, because that's where all these people were, to get them out of hell. She responded to the call of Jesus. So, she devoted her life. She began studying psychology. That was 55 years ago. When she was going through a challenging time due to her own mental illness, she often went to a small Catholic chapel and prayed.

One night she was kneeling in there, looking up at the cross, and the whole place became gold – and suddenly she felt something coming toward her ... It was a shimmering experience, and she just ran back to her room and said, 'I love myself.' It was the first time she remembered talking to herself in the first person. She felt transformed.

She earned PhD in psychology, started her internship at The Suicide Prevention and Crisis Service. She went through numerous cycles of trial and error one after another, but she endured. She learned from the mistake and moved on and got better year after another, and eventually developed a unique behavioral therapy that resulted in 60% reduction on suicide. Her behavioral therapy is widely recognized now that this therapy is now turned into behavioral skill that many middle schools in America adopt this as a curriculum course to teach and is well accepted and getting popular.

When I see her talk, she comes across as a down to earth, genuine and humble person who has charisma to attract people. I feel she knows what drives Christ.

She responded to the call of Jesus and lived her own life fully as a faithful disciple.

The story of Jesus enters into her own story. Her life story was woven into the story of Jesus. She reminds me of St. Paul's letter to the Colossian.

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, as in all wisdom you teach and admonish one another, singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God" (Colossians 3:16)
