

Stages of Faith

Many Catholics believe that faith is something you either have or don't have. And once you have faith, it's yours as long as you don't deliberately get rid of it. There are as many different degrees of faith as there are people in this Church. Even more significantly, there are many stages of faith; there are numerous levels of growth in our understanding of who Christ is. Faith can either grow and mature or slowly fade away throughout life. In today's Gospel, we see the development of faith exemplified in the dialogue between Jesus and the woman at the well; this dialogue can serve as a paradigm of our growth in faith and relationship with Christ.

Notice how today's Gospel of John presents the development of faith with Jesus.

1. It begins with a chance meeting, not as something one deliberately sought out: "A woman of Samaria came to draw water." 2. The dialogue starts with Jesus' request for

water: "Give me a drink."

3. Quickly she begins to see a deeper significance in Jesus' response: I "would have given you living water."

4. Soon Jesus puts the dialogue on a very personal level: "You have had five husbands."

5. Then the woman realizes they are dealing with sacred matters, but still feels confident: "Our ancestors worshipped (God) on this mountain."

6. Eventually she realizes that this man is the Messiah: "I am the Messiah, the one who is speaking with you."

7. Finally she brings her neighbors to Jesus. Just like her own personal growth in faith, they also make a personal, mature choice for themselves: "We have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is truly the savior of the world."

The encounter seems to be John's deliberate paradigm for our faith growth in various

stages.

Stage 1. Our beginning of faith is not something we sought out or desired. For almost all of us, chance brought us to Christ. Our parents or friends happened to be Christian, so they brought us to the water of baptism.

Stage 2. Then, as a child or a beginner, we came to realize that God is our heavenly Father who cares for us; we can pray to him for our material or spiritual needs; we can expect his grace and protection.

Stage 3. In the early years of learning about our faith, we learned that God does make some difference in our lives; he makes demands that refer to our daily lives. Some of us practically stop our faith development here and fade away, for we prefer God who leaves us alone; we like to believe in a good God up in heaven, but one who has little place in human living.

Stage 4. We don't want to think of faith in God as a deeper level of personal love that instills all of human life. God is not the priority in our lives. Sunday worship suffices. We just don't have room for him in our daily lives.

Stage 5. Perhaps as an adult, we came to realize that this God is the Lord of all life whom we need to recognize and worship. But we still believe that an occasional gesture towards worshipping him should be enough, for he is, after all, a forgiving God. This too is far from a mature faith. God wants us to worship him "in Spirit and truth." For our true worship in the Spirit, Jesus himself is our necessary food: "Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man... you do not have life within you" (John 6:53). The Eucharist is our constant contact for maintaining our life in Jesus. Christ has given you as a fountain of eternal life that will never thirst for those who follow him with a thirsty heart.

Stage 6. A further aspect of mature faith is to realize the place of God in our lives. We come to realize that Jesus is the one who brings the final revelation about God; He is the entire Word of God's revelation to us; we are entirely dependent on his truth and grace; our destiny is in his hands. This is a critical step for us Christians. For we want to be self-reliant and

self-sufficient; we want to possess our own life, and control our destiny. We are not comfortable with feeling needy or dependent. Stage 7. Finally, beyond all this, there are numerous other steps that we struggle to take all our life long. Such development only comes with time and effort, with saying "yes" to the individual reality that is our life. It depends on Jesus and ourselves as we try to make him the Lord of our own individual life: "We have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is truly the savior of the world." We are made to experience and encounter God through our senses. They heard for themselves to know Jesus is truly the savior of the world.

Not only do we see Jesus as the Savior of the entire world, but we see him as our person Savior, the center of our life, the model for our living. Jesus reveals God is the Holy Sp and the Spirit is also personally the livir water welling up from Christ crucified as source and welling up in us to eternal I (CCC 694).

Through this church, Christ awaits us enable us to drink and eat of His Body an Blood in the unity of the Holy Spirit. Let us continue to grow in this faith in Chri all our life long and especially during this Le to prepare ourselves for the upcoming Pa sion so that we together with Christ ca experience a new life through Resurrection Easter.
